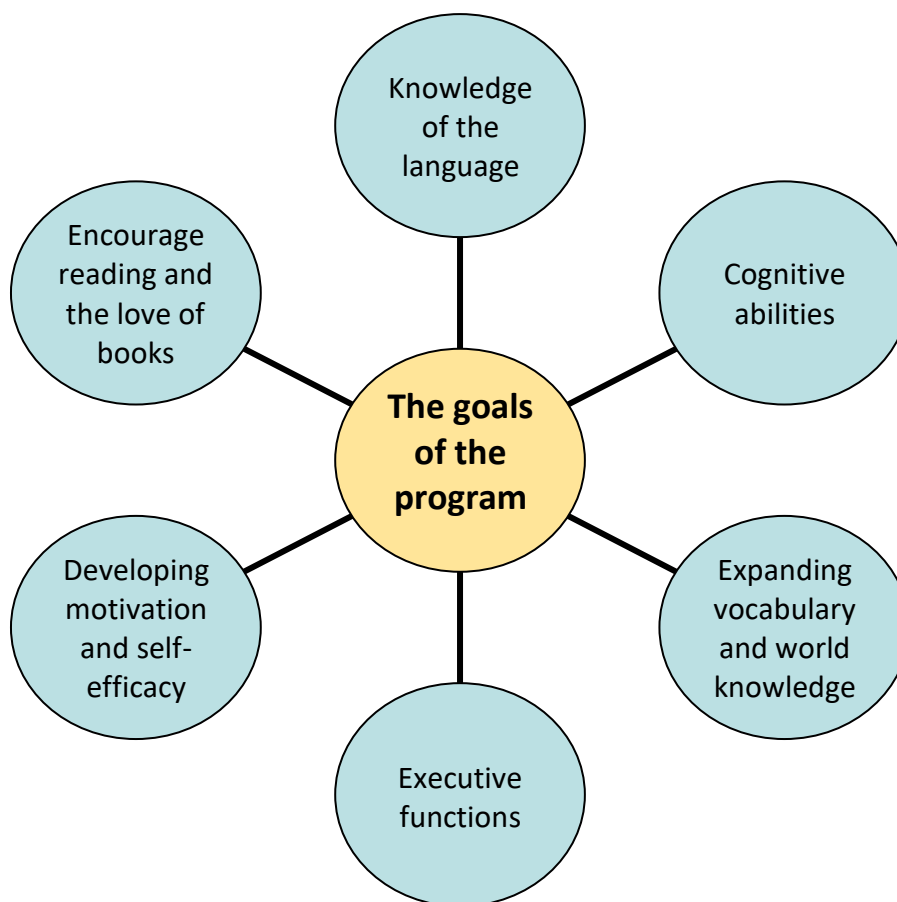


## “Let's Think About Language” Program

The school year 2023-2024 has been a challenging one, both emotionally and educationally. Taking that into consideration, the “Let's Think about language” program aimed at helping pupils at all levels.

The program supports pupils who face hardships in linguistic skills, reading fluency, writing and reading comprehension. This support consists of not only emotional motivation, but also cognitive and meta-cognitive aspects. This is in addition to enhancing the mental and emotional wellbeing of individuals and groups throughout the period of the war.

In particular, this year we emphasized vocabulary enrichment to improve pupils' ability to express themselves, and to promote reading and listening skills.



The PUSH Association and the Municipality of Or Yehuda conducted a joint program with **157 students** from seven schools in Or Yehuda, called "Let's Think About Language".

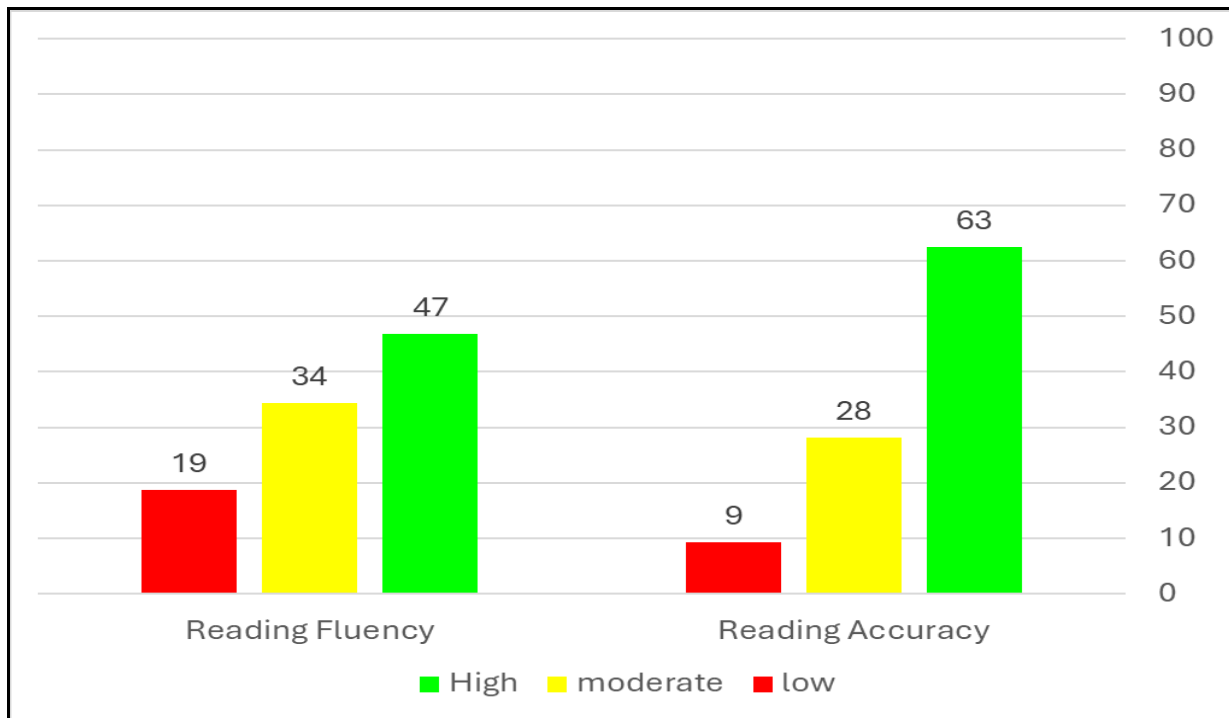

**Achievements of PUSH Remedial Students in First Grade Reading Tasks (%) 2023-2024**

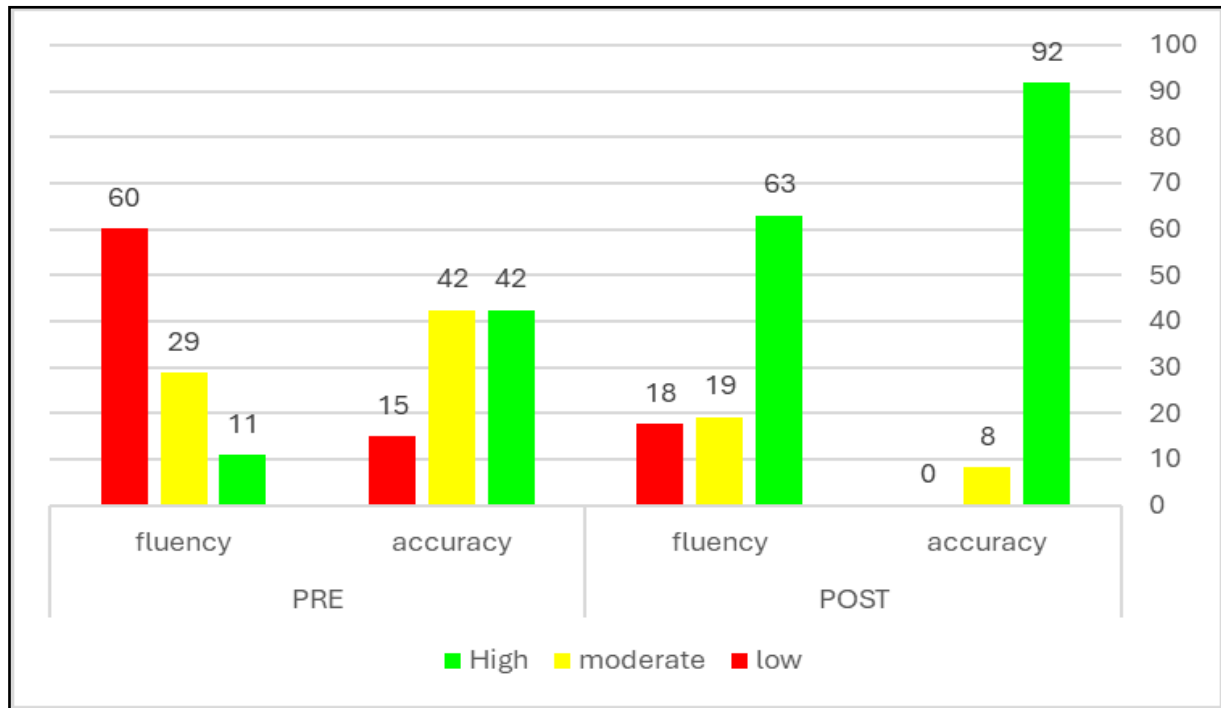
